Submission Guidelines

1. Eligibility

3. Abstract and Full Paper Requirements

- **Abstract:** Maximum 300 words. Must clearly summarize the objective, methodology, key findings, and relevance to the summit theme.
- Full Paper: Between 3,000 to 5,000 words, including references.
- Font and Style: Times New Roman, 12-point font, double-spaced.
- Language: English.
- **Citation Format:** APA 7th Edition.

4. Submission Process

Submissions must include:

- Title of the paper
- Author(s) full name(s), institutional affiliation(s)
- Contact details (email, phone)
- Abstract
- Full paper in Word or PDF format

- Abstract Submission Deadline: May 1, 2025
- Notification of Acceptance: May 10, 2025
- Final Paper Submission Deadline: May 20, 2025

6. Review Process

Each submission will undergo a double-blind peer-review process. Review criteria include originality, thematic relevance, methodology, and clarity.

7. Presentation at the Summit

Accepted authors will be invited to present during thematic plenary or breakout sessions. Presentations should be impactful, clear, and suitable for a multidisciplinary audience, including government representatives, investors, and development partners.

8. Publication Opportunities

Selected high-quality papers may be published in the official AICIS 2025 Proceedings and considered for publication in affiliated journals or policy platforms focusing on sustainable development and climate issues.
